Conference on Awareness of Ayurveda in Canada- 23 July, 2022

As part of the #AzadiKaAmritMahotsav, Consulate General of India, Vancouver, in partnership with Sewanti, Vancouver organised a Conference on 'Awareness of Ayurveda in Canada' in Surrey on 23 July, 2022. The keynote speaker for the event was Dr. Martina Ziska, Czech Ayurvedic Scholar with a strong background in clinical research, medical publishing and clinical experience in ayurvedic and allopathic medicine.
